The rules:

- A. Concert dance shall NOT be allowed.
- B. Displays of practiced skill may be deemed over-polished and boring by the esteemed panel of "semi-celebrity" judges. Perform at your own risk.
- C. Concert dance shall NOT be allowed.
- D. Contestants and contestant groups must be directly affiliated with the department. In other words, your best friend cannot perform unless you are performing with him/her/it.
- E. Concert dance shall NOT be allowed.
- F. "Celebrity" judges maintain the right to gong performers off the stage after 45 seconds of performance.
- G. "Celebrity" judges maintain the right to physically prevent other "celebrity" judges from gonging acts off the stage.
- H. Concert dance shall NOT be allowed.
- I. Any stage act that may potentially damage the theatre or Sullivant's facilities will not be performed.
- J. Rehearsals on stage, in anticipation of the **NO-TALENT TALENT GONG SHOW**, shall NOT be allowed.
- K. Special lighting will NOT be allowed.
- L. Sound playback is relegated to CD only. No I-Pods. Live music will be performed acoustically. One vocal mic will be made available to performers.
- M. Concert dance shall NOT be allowed.
- N. One "Golden Gong" Trophy shall be awarded to the victorious act. Its value probably amounts to nothing more than short-lived bragging rights.
- O. As this is event is purely for fun, hurt feelings, crying, or taking oneself too seriously SHALL NOT BE ALLOWED.
- P. Acts may be no longer than three minutes.
- Q. All contestants & performing acts must sign-up by May 16 to be eligible to perform in the **NO-TALENT TALENT GONG SHOW**. You'll find this sheet posted on the costume-shop door.
- R. Oh, yes. Concert dance shall NOT be allowed.
